Race 1 - The Edward Symmons LLP Maiden Stakes over 6 Furlongs

Hathrah can land this much deserved victory after being the perennial bridesmaid on all her starts, recently decent 2nd to Nasij over a mile and has always looked to possess plenty of speed, she can make her experience count against these less exposed types and open her account. Main dangers come from Bill Smiths runner Musaayar who is full brother to the unbeaten Albaab, and stablemate's Furaat 3rd on her debut over 7 f behind Nahdah and Anayid a half sister to speedy handicapper Tash Reefat.

Race 2 - The iimia Wealth Management Open Race over 7 Furlongs

Its hard to oppose Fraternity who has won his last three starts on the bounce from a 8 – 10 furlongs, drop down in trip doesn't look like it will inconvenience and can continue making hay in these events. His main danger is from Diamond Ring who won over this trip last season and comes form the in form Bill Smith yard, whilst Inchmarlow has chased him home twice and may just overturn him at this shorter trip.

Race 3 - The Eastwood Farm Arabians Maiden Stakes over 1 Mile 2 Furlongs

Almutasader was out stayed by Estival at Huntingdon over 1 Mile 4 furlongs but he is entered in the Derby and can take this race to make amends for his earlier defeat. Palapal ran well when 5th to Derby hope Mutafanen over this trip at Fontwell and has place claims as does Pacific Way, who was an eye catching 4th that day.

Race 4 - The Penn Challenge Handicap Stakes (Anglo's & PBA's) over 1 Mile

L'Escalou has always been a class act and champion anglo several years in a row, he goes well fresh and can open his account for the season. Fontwell winner Curupanna, Madrison and Tamagotchi are big dangers and will be fighting out the finish.

Race 5 - The Jebel Ali Racing Club Handicap Stakes 0-50 over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs

Fair Deed Dash ran well on her debut when third to Kizhi over 1 Mile 4 furlongs and can open her account for the season here. Her main dangers are from stablemate Mushammer who has been running with credit including when 4th to Gazal over a mile, whilst Eternal Light loves this track and won over 2 miles here last season.

Race 6 - The ARO Sweepstakes Handicap Stakes 0-65 over 2 Miles

Consider Me ran well when 3rd behind Estival at Huntingdon over 1 Mile 4 furlongs and looks to be crying out for this trip, he can take this en route to better races. Floren won well over 1 Mile 4 furlongs on his debut at Wolverhampton and should be in the shake up as should Kizhi who won nicely under top weight at Fontwell over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs and looks to be progressing.

Race 7 - The "Angela's 40 In A Fortnight" Handicap Stakes 0-80 over 6 Furlongs

Nahdah recorded a brave all the way victory on only her second start when winning over 7 furlongs at Fontwell, she can follow up here for in form trainer Julian Smart. Djak Sprat looked impressive when landing his handicap over this trip at Huntingdon and looks on the upgrade, whilst Yaasah wasn't disgraced on her debut when 3rd behind the improving Benamer and should be thereabouts.
