

**Race 1 – The Ward Estates Ltd Maiden over 1 Mile 1 Furlongs:**

Anayid was narrowly touched off by impressive juvenile winner Prince Dormant at Lingfield last week and can make amends here today for Champion trainer Gill Duffield. Her main dangers are Sharka who ran well when fourth on his debut at Wolverhampton over this trip the second and third that day have since won their maidens so the form looks solid, whilst Pacific Way ran well when fourth on her debut at Fontwell Park over 10 furlongs.

**Race 2 – The Brightwells OPEN race (TBs, AA & PBAs) over 7 Furlongs:**

Inchmarlow won impressively at Exeter over this trip beating multiple winner Fraternity and Night Cap, with Bold Maggie and Diamond Ring well beaten. His main dangers are Night Cap again who won over this trip last season and Diamond Ring who also won over this trip last season.

**Race 3 – The Jebel Ali Racing Club Handicap Stakes 0-50 over 1 Mile 1 Furlong:**

Mushammer looks all set for a hatrick for the in form Carol Legg yard, he won impressively at Exeter over 1 Mile 6 furlongs and again last week at Lingfield over 1 Mile 4 furlongs, looks to have plenty of pace so step down in trip won't be a problem. Ajyaal looked like the penny had finally dropped when winning convincingly at Lingfield last week over 6 furlongs and has place claims as does Glastonbury Pop who won well at Huntingdon over this trip.

**Race 4 – The Brunton Handicap Stakes 0-75 over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs:**

Debrett won well at Exeter over 2 Miles beating stablemate Kizhi, yard is in form and he can follow up here. Consider Me ran well when third to Estival at Huntingdon over this trip, the second has since won and he has place claims today as does Kizhi who won under top weight over this trip at Fontwell Park.

**Race 5 – The Newcomer Handicap Stakes 0-60 over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs:**

Mehshiv has been running well in defeat all season including just failing to get up over a mile to Gazal at Fontwell, he relishes a stamina sapping trip and was third over two miles to stablemate Debrett at Exeter and can gain a well deserved win here. Main dangers come from Floren who won well over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs at Wolverhampton and SA Bibi who was third that day.

**Race 6 – The Shaw & Fox OPEN race over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs:**

Cordage had been running well in defeat until opening his account in a farcical race at Lingfield last week over two miles, he can win again here for the in form James yard. Tamagotchi impressed when 2<sup>nd</sup> to Curupanna over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs at Fontwell and has place claims here, whilst Ardente Sauvage makes her belated seasonal debut and will love the track and won over 1 Mile 2 furlongs last season.

**Race 7 – The Jebel Ali Handicap Stakes 0-70 over 7 Furlongs:**

Benha looked to be returning to form when just touched off by Al Mamoon over this trip at Lingfield Park last week, he can score here. His main danger comes from Operatic who was third to Earlsdon over 6 furlongs at Wolverhampton and ran well

recently when 5<sup>th</sup> in competitive handicap over 10 furlongs. Whilst WA Savannah Sunrise ran well when third to Al Mamoon over this trip and should be thereabouts.

**Race 8 – The Anglo Arab Handicap Stakes 0-140 over 1 Mile 1 Furlong:**

Curupanna looked very impressive when scooting up at Fontwell over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs where she had Marmot D'Estruval well beaten back in fourth, she followed up at Exeter over a mile and will take all the beating today. Marmot D'Estruval has place claims, whilst Hardtoback won several races over this trip a couple of years back and should be thereabouts.
