Race 2 - SA Bibi can open his account for the season with trip and track ideal. Main dangers come from The Way To Go and the unexposed Bill Smith runner Djak Sprat.

Race 3 - Market Rasen winner fraternity can follow up with a quick double here. Kings Cavalier and Tamagotchi will give him most to do.

Race 4 - Mack The Knife makes his seasonal debut and can win this from top weight for Angela Cook who has a great strike rate with her runners. Newmarket based Gill Duffield's lightly raced Muzmin is a big danger as is Rampart who steps up in trip after an encouraging debut at Wolverhampton.

Race 5 - WFA Leopard can win this for local owner Linda Allen, he won a big race over 6 furlongs last year and is as tough as they come. Bill Smith's smart Wolverhampton winner Earlsdon and the talented Tash Reefat will make him pull out all the stops.

Race 6 - Open race and PBA La Perruche will love track and trip and can beat the Thoroughbreds here, Tremezzo for the powerful Emma Owen yard and Extra Cover will make her pull out all the stops.

Race 7 - Bodiddle can take this after his impressive 6 furlong victory at Wolverhampton, Glastonbury Pop will love track and trip and El Buba second last week shows he is returning to form.

Race 8 - Gill Duffield can take this final maiden with the useful looking Almutasader, big dangers come from Angel Colledge's Estival who was running on when third at Wolverhampton on her debut and Gazal who was fourth and will appreciate the step up in trip.
