Race 1 – Maiden Over 7 Furlongs

His main dangers come from Edjalie who was second on her debut over 6f to Hathrah at Exeter last week and Furaat who was third to Nahdah at Fontwell and looked to be a speedy sort.

Race 2 – Jebel Ali Handicap 0-45 over 1 Mile 4 Furlong

A competitive low grade handicap and a fine opportunity for impressive Market Rasen scorer El Chenz to add to his victory, his main danger comes from Mushammer who was impressive winning over this trip at Exeter last week from Anganate Safinat who also has place claims.

Race 3 – 1 Mile Open

L'Escalou won impressively at this track last season and goes well fresh and can open his account for the season. Main dangers come from TBs Bold Maggie and Princess Karla who will appreciate the trip.

Race 4 – Handicap 0-90 over 1 Mile

Madid was an impressive maiden winner last season and was slightly disappointing on his seasonal reappearance at Market Rasen behind Malik D'Or, he can regain the winning thread here. Main dangers come from Badee who drops down in trip and impressive Wolverhampton winner Earlsdon.

Race 5 – 2 Miles Open

La Perruche loves a test a stamina and this gallant Anglo can win this race for the second year in a row. Main dangers come from Cordage who will appreciate the trip and Mattoni.

Race 6 – Jebel Ali Handicap 0-75 over 1 Mile

Djak Sprat looked impressive when scoring impressively at Huntingdon over 6f, he gets 6lbs from top weight and can win again. Pavots Dreamboy looked good when winning easily over 6 f at Exeter and will make the selection pull out all the stops, whilst Al Mamoon has strong place claims.

Race 7 – Conditions 1 Mile 4 Furlongs

Malik D'Or is a course and distance winner and won over this trip at Market Rasen in May, he can follow up here. CS Al Wahed loves stamina sapping trips and has strong place claims.

Race 8 – Sweepstakes Handicap 0-55 over 6 Furlongs

An ideal opportunity for The Way To Go to win again, she's been running well in defeat and trip and track will suit. Main dangers come from Wolverhampton distance winner Bodiddle and El Buba.
