**The Allington Maiden Stakes over 7 Furlongs**

Bill Smith has found a perfect opportunity for Sangelak to get his head in front, he was a decent second on his debut behind Anayid who has won again since and he can take this en route to better races. His main danger is the classy Pacific Way who was second to Mustajib on her last start, he has won again since so the form looks solid, whilst Magnum De Piboul didn't show much in France as a juvenile but hails from the all powerful Duffield yard and merits respect.

**The iimia Wealth Management Handicap Stakes 0-95 over 1 Mile**

Osaira ran a big race when third in the Group 1 Hatta Mares stakes and previously won over this trip at Huntingdon beating Jelvita, she can take this event under top weight. Stablemate Angel Picamer is a big danger having won a valuable Premier handicap at Lingfield and following up in the Mile handicap on Dubai Day, whilst Earsldon has chased home both Angel Picamer and Hathrah recently and merits respect. Odds on Bill Smith landing a 1,2,3!!!!

**The Thruxton Down Open Handicap Stakes over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs**

Bill Smith's yard is in fine form this term and the impressive Malik D'Or can take this, he has won two of his three starts and missed Dubai Day so will be nice and fresh to take this race. His main danger is Taabeer who was a brave 2<sup>nd</sup> to his brother Aljaareh in the stayers handicap over this trip on Dubai Day and should be thereabouts, as should Deolali who was a good third to Aljaareh that day.

**The Jebel Ali Racing Club Stakes 0-75 over 7 Furlongs**

Bill Smith's runner is again the selection, CS Charma was an excellent staying on second to Shuhood in the 7 furlong opening handicap on Dubai Day; he should be able to open his account here. His main danger is from Estival who hasn't been out of the frame in four runs to date, she won a competitive maiden well and was a good third to Paul De Faust and she will make the selection pull out all the stops; whilst Pavots Dreamboy is back to a winning mark and was 5<sup>th</sup> to Shuhood on Dubai and 2<sup>nd</sup> to Furaat over 6f before.

**The ARO Sweepstakes 0-60 over 1 Mile**

Blu By You has been running well all season improving with every run including when 3<sup>rd</sup> to Karang over 2 Miles at Nottingham, he can lose his maiden tag here. Mustameet was running well before disappointing at Fontwell, he's been freshened up now and will be in the shake up, whilst Pepita De Carrere has been running well over these trips and although outclassed on Dubai Day she was a good third to Jana over 6f at Notts; she has strong place claims.

**The Bishopstone Extended Handicap Stakes 0-45 over 6 Furlongs**

Plus has been running well this season and was narrowly beaten by Bonham last time out over 10f and was previously a good third to Egypt over this trip, she can lose her maiden tag here. Egypt is a big danger and has won over this trip already this season, she should be thereabouts. Whilst CS Lafaz can't be discounted over this trip at this level.
