

**Arabian Raceday Preview
Warwick 6th October**

1st race – Red Mills UK Maiden Handicap Stakes 0-70 over 7 Furlongs

A fine opportunity for the luckless The Debator to get her head in front, a good second on both her starts this season before disappointing behind CS Charma, she is tough and consistent and can take this race to open her account. Her main danger is Musaayar who was an average 3rd on his last start in a maiden, but is from a prestigious family and should be able to make his presence felt here. Pepita De Carrere has been running well in defeat this season and has strong place claims.

2nd race – The Easibed Open (TB, AA & PBA) Handicap race over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs

Fraternity has been turned over twice by Night Cap recently but previously notched up a 4 timer and doesn't have to contend with anything of the calibre of Night Cap today and regain his winning ways over ideal trip and track. His main danger is Adalar, who won so well over 1 Mile 6 furlongs at Nottingham, and Just Serenade, a class act who was a good second to Litigious over 1 Mile 6 furlongs at Wolverhampton last week.

3rd race – The Shaw & Fox Handicap Stakes 0-105 over 7 Furlongs

Al Tibr has run some great races this season including second to Dahess in Group 1 Zabeel Stakes and also behind the powerhouse Nokomys over a mile at Sandown. He looks capable of opening his UK account here. Angel Picamer won her Premier handicap at Lingfield nicely over this trip and then followed up in the valuable mile handicap on Dubai Day; she'll give her stable mate a run for his money. Whilst Hathrah won her Premier Handicap at Lingfield over this trip and was an excellent second to Anayid in the Breeders Cup over a mile.

4th race – Jebel Ali Gold Final 0-80 over 1 Mile 2 Furlongs

Roches Du Cayrou won emphatically at Stratford over 1 Mile 4 furlongs beating most of this field, trip and track ideal and the Thomas Stable in form and took this race last year. He is the one they all have to beat. Estival is an improving young mare and won her maiden well over 13 furlongs; she's been running well since including third to Paul De Faust over this trip, she has strong place claims. Jubilee Dancer ran a brave race when second to the selection at Stratford and will be thereabouts.

5th race – Jebel Ali Silver Final 0-80 over 1 Mile 2 Furlongs

Mushammer has notched up an impressive 4 timer this season including last week at Wolverhampton, smart individual and improving with every run, he looks the one to beat here. Main dangers come from Jana who won so well at Nottingham last time over 6f and who appears to have been kept for this race, and Blu By You won with plenty in hand at Wolverhampton over a mile last week and also looks on the upgrade.

6th race – Jebel Ali Silver Final 0-80 over 1 Mile 2 Furlongs

Raihan came right back to form with a decent victory over multiple winner Bonham last time out and she looks capable of taking this race in this company. Bonham has won twice this season including over this trip and will make her pull out all the stops. Whilst Sharka, Brigitta, Fair Deed Dash and El Hamsa should all be in the shake up based on their recent good form.

7th race – The Kingslea Stud Anglo & PBA Championship Stakes over 1 Mile 2 Furlongs

Curupanna has seemed unstoppable this season and has won all four starts impressively including over this trip, she beat Madrison, Tamagotchi and La Perruche last time out and is taken to confirm her superiority again today for a deserved championship victory. Her main danger is former Champion L'Escalou who can never be discounted and has been placed on both starts against TB's this season. Tamagotchi made the selection pull out all the stops at Stratford over 12 furlongs last time out and will be thereabouts.
