

**Arabian Raceday Preview
Wolverhampton 29th September**

1st Race – 0-60 Maiden Handicap over 1 Mile

A weak maiden on paper but this event can go to the progressive Mr Ben who was a decent 2nd to Jana over 6 f last time out on his handicap debut, the step up in trip should suit as he was staying on that day. His main dangers come from Blu By You who was disappointed last time out in a competitive renewal of the Breeders Cup, but was previously a good third to Karang over 2 Miles at Notts. Whilst Mustameet has been running well in defeat recently and wasn't disgraced when 4th of 8 to Moogali over this trip at Salisbury and can be forgiven a poor run at Stratford.

2nd Race – OPEN Race (Anglo,PBA & TB) over 6 Furlongs

Megabond has posted some solid efforts this term and deserves to get his head in front, he dead heated with the mighty Fraternity at Notts behind Night Cap and was again a good third behind those two at Stratford recently, he'll take all the beating. His main dangers are Ela Figura who has won over this trip this season at Huntingdon and Bold Maggie also a winner over 6 furlongs this season, they should be in the shake up.

3rd Race – Open Handicap (Pure Breds) over 1 Mile 1 Furlong

Anayid has proved to be a phenomenon this season with a hatrick of wins, she landed her maiden over a mile at Huntingdon, before hacking up over this trip at Nottingham and making all to win the Listed Breeders Cup renewal over a mile, she should be able to take this. Angel Picamer is in the form of her life this season and has recorded valuable victories at Lingfield in a Premier Handicap over a mile and on Dubai Day in the valuable mile Listed handicap, she'll make the selection pull out all the stops. Whilst Al Tibr has done nothing wrong this season posting a good second to powerhouse Dahess in the Group 1 Zaabeel Stakes over 6 furlongs and coming a fine 3rd to Nokomys over a mile at Sandown, he has strong place claims.

4th Race – Handicap Stakes 0-50 over 1 Mile 1 Furlong

Raihan ran a brave race in the Group 1 Hatta Stakes and showed her good heart with a game third to Floren in the Handicap Sweepstakes final at Stratford over a mile, she is an All weather specialist and a course and distance winner and should be able to land this prize. Her main dangers are Fair Deed Dash who showed her best bit of form for a while when chasing home Bonham over 1 Mile 4 f at Stratford last time out, whilst Bonham has landed a two timer winning over this trip at Nottingham and latest at Stratford, he looks progressive and will make the selection pull out all the stops.

5th Race – Handicap Stakes 0-90 over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs

Deolali has been in great form this season with a series of a good placed efforts including last time out when an excellent third to Aljaareh on Dubai Day in the Listed Stayers handicap over this trip, he will take all the beating here. Maestro Al Maury has had very little racing this season but was a good 2nd to stablemate Aljaareh over this trip at Market Rasen back in May, he should be thereabouts. Whilst Muzmin seems to have lost his way in his last two runs but was previously a good 2nd to stablemate Taabeer over this trip at Fontwell Park and has place claims if back on song.

6th Race – OPEN race (Anglo, PBA & TB) over 1 Mile 6 Furlongs

Adalar powered home at Nottingham over this trip last time out and that confident boosting run should see him come home again in this event. His main danger is Just Serenade who won 3 races last year from 1 Mile 4 f to 2 miles, she goes well fresh and trip and track should suit and she will make the winner work hard here. Whilst Princess Karla posted an excellent effort latest when 2nd to Adalar over this trip at Notts and the Wilson stable is in form and she could cause an upset.

7th Race – Handicap 0-75 over 6 Furlongs

Roches Du Cayrou seems to go over any distance and any trip and won convincingly a fast run 1 Mile 4 f handicap at Stratford last time out, this step down in trip shouldn't be a problem and he can win again. Pavots Dreamboy will give him most to do and won this race last year, he has won over 6 f this term and can never be discounted at this level. Whilst Al Mamoon is an all weather specialist and won nicely over a mile at Lingfield this year (with Benha and Pavots Dreamboy beaten), a good 4th last time out to Madid over this trip he should go close.

8th Race – Handicap 0-65 over 1 Mile 4 Furlongs

A competitive race and this event can go to rapidly progressing Mushammer who has won three this term and is improving with every run, he won well at Lingfield over this trip and was a good 3rd to CS Charma

over an inadequate 7 f last time out, he can take this for a four timer. His main danger is Operatic who last won over this course and distance a couple of seasons ago and is now on a lower handicap mark, he was a good third to Djaxy King over 1 Mile 6 f recently and should be there in the closing stages. Whilst Yakshi won on her handicap debut over 1 Mile 6 f at Huntingdon beating Notid and has strong place claims.
