

Bath 7th September Single Race Preview

The Royal Cavalry Of Oman Clarendon International Stakes (Group 3 PA) Over 5 Furlongs

The selection is smart performer and multiple Group winner **Nokomys**, she won a 6 furlong Group 2 sprint back in 2007 and last year landed the a 6 furlong Group 3 event at Great Leighs, from stablemates Angel Picamer and Aberfeldy. She's been in excellent heart this term, running second No Risk Al Maury in a Group 2 event at Newbury and just losing out by a neck in the Group 1 Hatta Stakes to Quesche Du Paon. The step down in trip will suit and she can gain a deserved victory. Duffield has the useful multiple 7 furlong winner Thimaar entered in addition to Ayun, who won her only start over 9 furlongs last term and is still relatively unexposed. Adam Newey has the Iraqi bred Al Harith, who was 2nd to Rabah De Carrere in a 6 Furlong Premier Handicap at Kempton and also 3rd to Dariya in the Group 1 Zaabeel Stakes on Dubai Day (Ircalan DA was 4th and Galaavi 6th). The Athbah Stud run Theoretically who was well beaten in the UK Derby but previously won the Bob Magness Derby in the USA and could improve for the step down in trip.
