The Premier Handicap will be for horses rated 40-65. **Jockeys will be allocated by draw.**

STEWARDS NOTICES

HEREFORD 5th JULY

RACE 3: The Stewards held an enquiry into the use of the whip by Mr Stephen Gregory, the rider of DJAZIRA. Having heard his evidence and viewed recordings of the race, they found him in breach of Rule 66 (vi) of the British Horseracing Authority Regulations for Arabian Horse Racing in that he had used his whip above the permitted level. They fined him £80.

RACE 7: The record of vaccinations in the passport of SOUTHWARK NEWSHAWK, trained by Mrs Hayley Lake, did not comply with the British Horseracing Authority Regulations for Arabian Horse Racing. The Stewards found the trainer in breach of Regulation 24 and fined her £60.

RACE 7: The Stewards held an enquiry following an objection by Mr Y T Mehmet, the rider of GRANNY ANNE (IRE), placed third, to CALL ME ROSY (IRE), placed second, ridden by Mr Zac Baker. The Stewards found that there was interference between CALL ME ROSY (IRE) and GRANNY ANNE (IRE) but after viewing a recording of the race they were unable to apportion blame. They therefore ordered the placings to remain unaltered.

RACE 8: The Stewards held an enquiry into the running and riding of ROYAL ACCLAMATION (IRE), ridden by Miss Alice Kenyon and trained by Mr R J Kington, which was held up in rear before making some progress under apparent tender handling in the straight to dead-heat for fourth place. They interviewed the rider and the trainer. Having heard their evidence and viewed recordings of the race the Stewards noted their explanations and no further action was taken.

ACCOMMODATION: Stable staff will be accommodated in local hotels. Please book as early as possible with the ARO Office.

INTERNATIONAL RACE ENTRIES: Close Wednesday 25th June at 12 noon.

HANDICAP RACE ENTRIES: Close Tuesday 29th July at 12 noon.

INTERNATIONAL RACE SUPPLEMENTARY ENTRIES: Close Tuesday 29th July at 12 noon (£300).

HORSE DECLARATIONS (including headgear): Close Wednesday 6th August at 11am.

JOCKEY DECLARATIONS: Close Thursday 7th August at 11am.

Please note that trainers not registered with ARO will be required to pay an annual administration fee of £50 + VAT to make an entry in an ARO race open to International horses.
