

Jockey Eligibility Summarised

DESIGNATED MEETING means any meeting or fixture where the sale of picture rights occurs in Great Britain for the purposes of off-course betting.

Regulation 32(ii)

Designated Meeting/ Races on TB card

(i.e. Group Races, Premier Handicap's, some conditions races)

- Pro Jockeys
- Cat B Jockeys
- ARO Jockeys and Cat A Jockeys with 20 rides and 3 wins - with experience from racing through stalls or received stalls training at a racing school equivalent to Cat A
(Rides and Wins must be from flat races under the Rules of a Recognised Turf Authority or Arabian Racing)
(Not including Pony racing rides or rides over fences)

Regulation 32 (vii) Amateur riders are entitled to claim the following riding allowances in Handicap Races run at a designated meeting/ thoroughbred fixture other than an Amateur Riders Race:

5lbs until they have won **10 races**, under Regulations for Arabian Racing, BHA Rules of Racing, any Recognised Turf Authority, or Point to Point Steeple Chases.

3lbs until they have won **25 races** as detailed above.

Regulation 32(iii)

Designated Meetings / Races on TB card

Amateur Riders races (as stated in the calendar) open to:

- Cat A
- Cat B
- ARO jockeys with 20 rides – with experience from racing through stalls or received stalls training at a racing school equivalent to Cat A
(Rides to include NH and PTP – any race ride under a recognised turf authority)
(Not including Pony racing rides)

Regulation 30

ARO Domestic race meeting:

- Cat A
- Cat B
- ARO jockeys
