

2013 has been another solid year for British bred race horses and endurance horses, and several key British Breeders have seen their horses achieve considerable success in major races.

ENDURANCE 2013

The Endurance National Champion for 2013 is Vavavoom (Vadeer x Vahana) owned and ridden by Carri-Ann Dark, and by AHS Premium stallion Vadeer, who has rapidly become one of leading endurance sires, he is also the sire of Kates Mate who won the 101 km ER at Carnwiche (also ridden by Carri-Ann). Carol Legg has also had a superb season with her homebred gelding French Lieutenant (Dedja Des Forges x Shirea Crystal (Crystal Magician) winning 120 km FEI 2 star at Kings Forest, 3rd in the 120 km FEI 2 Star Windsor ER and 1st in the 81 km ER at Three Rivers, as well as Terminators Dream (Bengali D'Albret x Dantes Dream (Dantist) winning the 80 km FEI 1 star at Barbury Castle and 3rd in the 80 km ER at Cirencester Park. Oakleaze Farm Czarko (Czarus x Nathalya) has so far this season won the 120 km FEI 1 star at Haywood Oaks, 2nd in the 120 km FEI 2 star at Kings Forreest, 1st in the 80km ER at Cirencester Park with Lauren Mills, and Vlacq Diamond Sparkle (Shah Shadow x Huttons Amber Chloe) took the 130 km 2 Day Cirencester Park ride and full sibling Vlacq Bronze Image was 4th in the 120 km 2 star at SERC in Scotland. While the Warrens Hill Arabians bred Warrens Hill Kizmet (Warrens Hill Destiny x Flo Jo) won the YR Championship for owner Alice Loten, Zayin Arabian Stud have also had their most successful season with Zayin Encantado (Karmah X Aliesha) - owned/ridden by Jenny Pierson winning the 100 km ER Gold Achievement race at Cirencester Park (Sakeena Sky Zayin came 2nd with Kumara Zayin 3rd – a rare 123 for any stud in the UK in an ER), Encantado has also come 2nd in the 80 km Boconnoc Bowl and the 80 km Barbury Castle Chase. While Yawl Hill Billy has been 3rd in the 100 km ER at Barbury Castle and Cirencester Park as well as gaining a Grade 1 for his NASTA Performance Test for owner/breeder Kirsty Wiscombe. While Kartoum With A K (Khairo x Dras Lass) bred by the late Cheryl Logan, but owned/ridden by Nikki Malcolm has won the 80 km FEI 1 Star at Kings Forest, 2nd in the 120 km FEI 2 Star at Ermelo (Holland), 1st in the 80 km ER at Cirencester Park and 120 km FEI 2 Star at the College Ride. While Jane Kadri bred mare Sadhira (Simeon Sadir x Sabeha) won the young horse title at Kings Forreest.

ARAB RACING 2013

This year's Arabian Racing season has seen no less than 14 individual UK winners, with Carol Legg and her father Eric's lovely young colt Man Of Dreams (Nizam x Dantes Dream) landing a hatrick of wins including a Premier Handicap at Newbury, Zayin Arabian Stud have won with both their runners this season, Zayin Shamern (Concord x CS Shamal) hacking up by 10 lengths in his maiden and Zayin Zachilles (Kaolino x CS Comete) winning by 6 lengths on his handicap debut. Jane Haddock's smart stallion Ambrose (Amer x KTP Mystic Flight) has also won twice including the opening handicap on Dubai Day. Other winners include the Lou Bennet bred LB Armanii (Sambist x WFA Naema) winning his maiden by 5 lengths, Adam Newey's smart colt Flashback (Fadjik x Sing Me A Song) winning at Salisbury, Jenny Peyton bred Trip To Khairo (Khairouan x Tikis Trip), the Jo and James Kippen bred Our Princess (Prince Dormant x Balladore), the Christine Cone bred Millenium Leap (Khairouan x Balla Star), Senor Dublcheck (Bengali D'Albret x Mais) winning for David Paton and the Liz Harrington bred pair Whisper (The Wiking x Sucha) and Suchaking (The Wiking x Sucha). Special mention for El Adjban (Makzan x Shunah) coming 2nd in the Group 3 Clarendon Stud 5 furlong sprint.

VADEER (Mamluk x Viola (Naftalin)- Won 10 races and was placed 11 times winning over £77,000 in UK and UAE and set three race records. His placed efforts included 2nd in the Al Ain International Derby and the Al Nahiyan International Stakes, and 3rd in the UAE Presidents Trophy and the Group 1 Dubai Stakes. During his prolific career he beat some of the best races horses in Europe and the UAE including Passem Lotois, Dent Du Loup, Darike, Akbar, Chndaka and Makzan.

CHATANZ (Bonanza (Banat) x Chatelaine (Klarnet)):

An incredible stallion who like his sire and dam has been a real flag bearer for breeder Lesley Dunn. His sire Bonanza has sired numerous top class endurance horses including Lesley's own Franzara EGB Endurance Champion mare and WAHO award winner, Delorto Zaranz who competed in the 160 km Presidents Cup in Abu Dhabi this February representing the UK and EGB National endurance champion Bonnie Anne. Chatanz's dam Chatelaine was an incredible race mare a Grade 1A winner of the Long Distance Championship and the British Bred mares Championship. Chatanz himself was a Grade 1 A racehorse winning the British Bred Championship at Goodwood where he beat several notable French stayers. He is NASTA performance tested and an AHS Premium stallion. Chatanz has also got many Grade 1's in endurance rides competing in both Advanced and FEI endurance rides and represented Britain in Belgium in 2002. He won the 65km Berkshire Downs and was 2nd in the Cotswolds 80km ER as well as being 4th in 2003 AHS marathon.

This superb racehorse won 12 times during a long race career over 5 seasons and his wins came over a variety of distances from 5 furlongs sprints to 1 Mile 5 Furlongs staying races. His biggest win came in the British Bred Championship at Lingfield Park. This versatile stallion has now completed the AHS Marathon three times and came 4th in 2008 and achieved advanced status in endurance in 2006. Al Reeh Janoob was awarded the WAHO Trophy 2012, and his stock are now starting to make a name for themselves in endurance.

KRAYAAN DILMUN (By Ma'anagy Nadeem out of Kray Manifa) . Bred by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed

bin Sulman Alkhalifa. A pure Bahraini stallion Krayaan Dilmun is the sire of three of our young stallions and during 2010 was The UK Leading Endurance Sire for Potential Endurance Horses. His offspring have been successful in Endurance up to FEI Standard and his grandchildren are winning on the race track back in his homeland of Bahrain, including Frayaa – winner of the 120km Dragons Tail race. He has also had his first runner in the UK Shuwaiman Al Kebir who was 3rd over a mile in his second start at Taunton this year.

Benamer is the only son of the incomparable Arabian race sire Amer (sire of Group 1 winners in Europe, Qatar and UAE) at stud in the UK and available by natural covering (other Amer son's are available by AI). Benamer was a smart race horses winning twice over 7 and 8 furlongs and being placed numerous times including when 2nd in the 1 Mile 2 Furlong Jebel Ali Gold Final. His dam was a smart sprinter who several races over 5 and 6 furlongs.

TIDARBRET (Bengali D'Albret x Iktidar) –

The only son of Bengali D'Albret (former UK champion sire and sire of Group 1 winners in Europe, UAE and America) at stud in the UK, and out of the top class mare Iktidar who won several races from 7-10 furlongs, and produced useful performer Prince Dormant who won in the UK before being exported to Oman where he won and is now a sire. Iktidar's dam Juans Karita Ku had 14 firsts racing and many top 3 placings in the USA, including prestigious G1 races such as the Gladys Brown Edwards Memorial.

Tidarbret himself is a top class race horse winning several races from 8-10 furlongs including the Breeders Cup, really came into his own this year starting with a 3rd in the 1m 1f Emirates Equestrian Federation Stakes at Wolverhampton 5th May, and then on 27th May this year he stormed home to win the President of the UAE Cup in great style at the Curragh Ireland beating some of America and Qatar's top racehorses over 1m, following up with a strongly contested 2nd in the 1m 2f Newbury Group 1 Arabian Horse Organisation Hawthorn Hill International Stakes in June.

DEEMONSTRATOR (Kayeed x Minstrella) –

Beautiful black Arabian stallion. His sire: KAYEED: Youngest horse ever to take gold at The Golden Horseshoe Ride. Went on to win/be placed in endurance races up to 75 miles including FEI. Fastest horse ever to win the AHS Marathon (2003). Believed oldest horse ever to start Arab racing, holding his own against the young French-bred horses and given a rating of 60. 2nd by a length in the Listed Jebel Ali Bronze Final at 16 years old. Currently still in training. Sire of Evermore Exciting on Senior Endurance long list. His dam: MINSTRELLA: Minstrella is sired by AL SOOD who is the sire of several 100 and 160km endurance horses. Al Sood is also sire of Arab racing winner Nicholettah. Minstrella is the dam of several pure, part and Anglo Arabs including Wandering Free 1997 Skewbald mare by Stetsen. She is an intermediate level endurance horse.

Billys' Sire the pure bred Arab Dhruv is an Arab horse society premium stallion who is the sire of several advanced Endurance horses including Dacoit and Jade Rani, who have been on the British team, and senior squad horse Java Sunlight. His dam Billy's dam is Burrowshot Lass a 16.1hh 7/8 thoroughbred mare who competed in a range of disciplines, was in the area show jumping and eventing teams at riding club level, won Stockland Lovell 2DE and was a very successful endurance horse. She was on the Endurance intermediate Squad 2000 and competed up to 100 km. Yawl Hillbilly himself has successfully competed in eventing and has proved to be extremely talented in endurance, in 2010 wins the Endurance GB FEI Championships in addition to Ross Trophy, 3rd, awarded to the most successful horse/pony bred by its current owner Windard Best New Horse Trophy, 2nd, awarded to the horse/pony gaining the most points in Endurance Rides in its first ER season. MARCUS AURELIUS (Aurelian x Fiesta Magica by Dargee Star) –

Marcus Aurelius is predominantly Crabbet Arabian with Davenport lines through his grandsire Ben Rabba. Through Ben Rabba he is also in direct male descent from Nasik – an important Crabbet line. He is performance bred both sides with Ben Rabba and his sire Aurab featuring strongly in their native USA (and also through exports to South Africa and Israel) in the breeding of modern day performance Arabians, endurance horses in particular. Although his sire Aurelian was mainly used as a sire for the show ring (and still features there most notably through his grandson from daughter Lianna, the multi-medal winning colt Design for Life), in addition to Marcus Aurelius he sired the race-winning stallion Istfahan and the 160km endurance gelding Aurontes. Of the 4 progeny of Marcus Aurelius' dam Fiesta Magica to have competed in endurance, 3 have achieved Advanced level with the youngest having qualified to upgrade to Open in her first season this year.

Marcus Aurelius is himself an Advanced endurance horse with several successful completions at 80km including in 2013 alone, grade 1 in the 80km class at Berkshire Downs, winning the performance formula for that distance at Cirencester and, as a last minute substitute horse for 14 year old Katherine Bertram in her first attempt at a 80km ride, 3rd in the performance formula at Lions Tail.

Marcus Aurelius passed his NaStA performance test as a 7 year old and is an Arab Horse Society Premium Performance Stallion. There are therefore monetary benefits from the Arab Horse Society available to the owners of mares accepted into the scheme and wishing to breed to him at the time of registration of a foal. His progeny are also eligible for BEF Futurity in all categories, his part-bred 2013 filly Scirrocco gaining a first premium for her breeder in the Endurance section at Plumpton this year. Despite the focus on endurance, he continues to compete against all breeds in all disciplines - those involving jumping in particular – primarily with his junior rider. He also attends the prestigious BEF organized stallion parade representing the Pure-bred Arabian in January each year.

The eldest progeny for Marcus Aurelius are beginning to come out under saddle. Avonbrook Silver Eagle (age 7) successfully completed his first endurance ride at Cranham in 2013 and will come back out in 2014. Avonbrook Odin (also 7) has started his career in dressage and 5 year old Avonbrook Silver Augury will be show-jumping affiliated classes with an amateur rider this winter thus between them underlining the versatility of their sire.

R ALI BEY (Magic Dream Cahr x Bey Affair) is now standing at private stud in Spain and the AI licence held by Mrs Jo Claridge is the only one in the UK. R Ali Bey has sired numerous show arabian champions and Phoenix Field Arabians 'Maarhabi' was one of them, winning the Egyptian championships as a 3 year old. As a 10 year old he joined the World Start and Potential Endurance Squad and started his FEI career in 2012 achieving 3rd place at Barbury Castle in the FEI 1*. In 2013 Maarhabi gained 3rd place at Barbury Castle in the FEI 2* class and narrowly missed his second 2* at the College Ride by 7 minutes over the 13kmph qualifying speed. Maarhabi has also completed the Arab Marathon and Man V's Horse in addition to Endurance GB events. Ali Shamahl and Ali Shahrif bred by Jo & Peter Claridge received Higher First Premium Awards at the BEF Futurity in 2010 and 2011 respectively with Ali Shahrif being awarded the leading endurance foal title of 2012. His daughter Shalisha has commenced her non-competitive ridden endurance career with Annie Lovell and Shamahl commenced his at Boconnoc this summer by completing the non-competitive 16km class. NEW TO THE LIST 2013/14

AL SOOD (Bay Saab (Saab) x Ansata Sahhara (Ansata Halim Son) –

Al Sood is a Black Straight Egyptian, great grandson of the legendary stallion Ansata Ibn Halima from the famous Ansata stud in the U.S.A. Thirteen generations back on his tail female line he is a descendent of the Abbas Pasha desert mare Ghazieh. Al Sood has been kept all his life in a non-competitive non-showing yard on a working farm. He was placed in hand at the Royal Highland Show – his only outing. As well as stud duties every year since a 2 year old he has been ridden extensively, hunted with the Duke of Buccleuch Foxhounds and taken part in many Borders Common Ridings, which can involve up to 400 horses.

A fertile and prepotent sire, Al Sood is a proven producer of quality foals who inherit his amazing temperament. They are sensible and renowned for trainability, taking everything in their stride. The quality and suitability of his offspring for endurance has become apparent over the years. As well as their strength, stamina and character it has been noted they have particularly good heart rate recovery. Al Sood was accredited as an Arab Horse Society Premium stallion in 2012 following the huge successes of his offspring and evaluation by an AHS judge.
