### SUMMARY

An interesting maiden with the debutants likely to have the edge if straight enough. Delicatesse's stable is in red hot form, but on last year's evidence she'll do better back in handicaps, whilst Pharitz Lahia's dam needed a few runs to get off the mark and likely she'll be the same. Phil Collington has three nicely bred types too, with the colts making most appeal. On pedigree they should be well suited to conditions with a narrow preference for MOBAASHER, who could make his age allowance tell.
