**Verdict**

A fascinating maiden to open the domestic UK Arabian season, with eight debutantes, many with nice pedigrees. Of those that have ran Mustafeed sets the standard he has some useful form from last season, he disappointed here when last seen but ran without the Blinkers he'd worn on his first two starts. They return here he should be capable of shedding the maiden tag at some stage. That said he comes up against some extremely well bred newcomers here Nadelshiba, Jeewan, Jinnan, Al Shaamkih and **Wanaasa** are the ones that appeal most, the latter gets a narrow vote receiving weight from all of her rivals.
